Abraham: A Journey of Faith

Meet the Father of a Nation
(Genesis 11:22-12:1)

11:22 When Serug had lived 30 years, he fathered Nahor. **23** And Serug lived after he fathered Nahor 200 years and had other sons and daughters. **24** When Nahor had lived 29 years, he fathered Terah. **25** And Nahor lived after he fathered Terah 119 years and had other sons and daughters. **26** When Terah had lived 70 years, he fathered Abram, Nahor, and Haran. **27** Now these are the generations of Terah. Terah fathered Abram, Nahor, and Haran; and Haran fathered Lot. **28** Haran died in the presence of his father Terah in the land of his kindred, in Ur of the Chaldeans. **29** And Abram and Nahor took wives. The name of Abram's wife was Sarai, and the name of Nahor's wife, Milcah, the daughter of Haran the father of Milcah and Iscah. **30** Now Sarai was barren; she had no child. **31** Terah took Abram his son and Lot the son of Haran, his grandson, and Sarai his daughter-in-law, his son Abram's wife, and they went forth together from Ur of the Chaldeans to go into the land of Canaan, but when they came to Haran, they settled there. **32** The days of Terah were 205 years, and Terah died in Haran. **12:1** Now the Lord said to Abram, "Go from your country and your kindred and your father's house to the land that I will show you.
