Andy and Rachel Meinzingler - Child Evangelism Fellowship

Grace Baptist Fellowship has recently started supporting Andy and Rachel Meinzingler. They are Natalie Finkbonner's daughter and son-in-law. They are assigned to Sri Lanka which is primarily a Buddhist country.

Pray for safety for them as they will be traveling many miles with their two young children as they raise their needed support. Pray that their car will hold up. Pray that they will be able to raise the needed funds.

Pray for a successful completion of a 4 week cross-cultural training program they will need to take before leaving for Sri Lanka.

Matt and Rachel Floreen - Malawi
