The Problem of Serious Troublemakers
(Titus 1:10-16)

1. How to spot serious troublemakers.
 - a. They dislike authority.
 - b. They talk a lot, but say little.
 - c. They twist peoples' thinking.
 - d. They are often hardline and narrow.
 - e. Their goal is to capture whole families.
 - f. They often contradict God's Word to gain money.
 - g. They are deceitful.
 - h. They are malicious.
 - i. They are controlled by their appetites.
 - j. They hate the truth.
 - k. They are morally corrupt.
 - l. They refuse to believe the gospel.
 - m. They pollute whatever they touch.
 - n. Their minds are twisted.
 - o. Their consciences are seared.
 - p. They claim to know God.
 - q. They are disgusting.
 - r. They refuse to obey.
 - s. They aren't capable of doing good.

2. How to handle serious troublemakers.
 - a. ¹¹ *They must be silenced . . .*
 - b. ¹³ *Therefore rebuke them sharply, that they may be sound in the faith.*

Important Things to Consider

- It is important to realize that serious troublemakers exist.
- It is important to know what serious troublemakers look like.
- It is important to pray for the elders who carry the load of dealing with serious troublemakers.
